
Reports Recap - The Dashboard

- The first page you see when you log into the Florida Ready to Work portal, offering cumulative data of all your learners' progress.
- Use the Calendar Icon to change the dates based on the data you want to see.
- Learners Enrolled is the total number of learners with access from your location.
- Active Learners is the total number of individuals within the date parameters who have used the system.



Reports Recap – Learner Listing


- Generates detailed information on accessed products for all active learners.
- Use when you want to compare more than one learner at a time in a single location during a specified time frame.





Reports Recap - Class Report


- Generates information by 'Class' that you create
- Defines groups of learners and allows you to see how they are progressing.






Reports Recap - Individual

- Generates information by individual learner.
- Use when you want to review one learner's activity progress from start to finish.




Reports Recap – Credential Summary ready to work

- Use when you want to see total number of credentials earned / not earned by product offering in your location.
- Can download and print multiple credentials at once.



Reports Recap – General Summary ready to work


 Provides high level activity results in all product offerings for leaners in one or more locations.



Reports Recap – Enrollment




Offers several views into the enrollment for learners.





Reports Recap – Learner Credential Summary

- Use when you want to see if individual passed or failed an assessment.
- Can download and print credentials.

- A great tool to use for SNAP/WT/ TANF to monitor your job seekers' career readiness / training progress and job search hours established.
- Can be used as an initial assessment to review academic skills set to determine workforce development program placement.
- Can use as a pre-qualifier for potential jobs / interviews.

- Make Soft Skills & Digital Skills Credentials a prerequisite for Work Based Learning / Applying for Apprenticeships
- Incorporate solution into Adult Education Programs IET, ESOL, GED
- Use Academic Employability Skills as a part of preparation for apprenticeships
- Career-contextualized instructional relevance for jobseekers requiring foundational math or reading refresher
- Require youth participants to earn Soft Skills & Digital Skills Credentials
 as a part of Summer Youth Program
- Tell YOUR Business Community
