


# Why Objective Based Reports?

- Understand learner's mastery of skills
  - Available currently for Digital Skills and Soft Skills; Academic Employability Skills Coming Soon
- Summary Report: shows the number of learners in the selected location who have mastered | not mastered the objectives in the selected date range for the selected solution.
- Individual Report: shows the individual's mastered | not mastered performance per objective in the courseware and/or assessment.
- Leaner Listing Report: shows list of learners in the selected location who have mastered | not mastered the objectives in the selected date range for the selected solution.
- Class Report: shows list of learners in the selected class who have mastered | not mastered the objectives in the selected date range for the selected solution.


### **Objective Based Reports – Summary**


