### **Attention Chromebook Users**

Google retired their Chromebook Kiosk App technology at the end of 2024, therefore the current Chromebook lockdown browser no longer works as of December 31, 2024.

In response, we have released a new Chromebook Lockdown Browser Extension to be used on Chromebook devices for proctored assessments. If you currently use Chromebooks to proctor the Florida Ready to Work assessments, please visit the WIN Resource Center located within the Florida Ready to Work portal and follow these instructions:

- Click on 'WIN CRSystem' in the top menu.
- Scroll down to 'Technology Verification' and select 'Click Here.'
- Click on 'Chromebook Lockdown Browser Instructions' for instructions on how to update your Chromebook Lockdown Browser to use the Extension.
