Google retired their Chromebook Kiosk App technology at the end of 2024, therefore the current Chromebook lockdown browser **no longer works as of December 31, 2024**.

In response, we have released a new Chromebook Lockdown Browser Extension to be used on Chromebook devices for proctored assessments.
