## ACTION REQUIRED: Update to Lockdown Browser Needed for Florida Ready to Work Assessments

An update to the WIN Career Readiness System is currently scheduled for the evening of **Wednesday, December 17, 2025**. The release will include updates to the Florida Ready to Work assessments.

On or before this date, the lockdown browser on **Windows** computers used for testing will need to be updated to **version 2.1.3.06**. **Please update the Windows lockdown browser to version 2.1.3.06 before December 17 to avoid testing issues.**

**If your learners use an Apple device or Chromebook, this update does NOT apply to you.**

If your learners are using Windows computers in your testing locations, we recommend that you verify with your local IT team that version 2.1.3.06 of the Windows lockdown browser is installed on the computers as soon as possible. In this month's update, items in the Academic Employability Skills Assessment have been refreshed to further align to the latest Academic Employability Skills Learning Objectives, developed using the [U.S. Department of Labor O\\*NET](#) Job Zone Framework and Detailed Work Activity (DWA) statements.
