**Resetting Your Password  
Best Practice Tips for  
Florida Ready to Work**

You and your participants can reset your passwords in the Florida Ready to Work / WIN Career Readiness System by first ensuring a valid email address is listed in your account.

- Click on the 'User Profile' icon in the top right corner.
- Then, check the box labeled “Send Verification Email” and click the “Save” button. You’ll receive an email asking you to confirm your address.
- Next time you or your participants forget their passwords, you can select the 'Forgot Password' link on [www.myfloridareadytowork.com](http://www.myfloridareadytowork.com) and change your password.
- Once an email address is confirmed for your participants, they can automatically get emails with links to their digital badges, certificates, and credentials whenever they earn them. Click [here](#) to learn more about digital badging.
